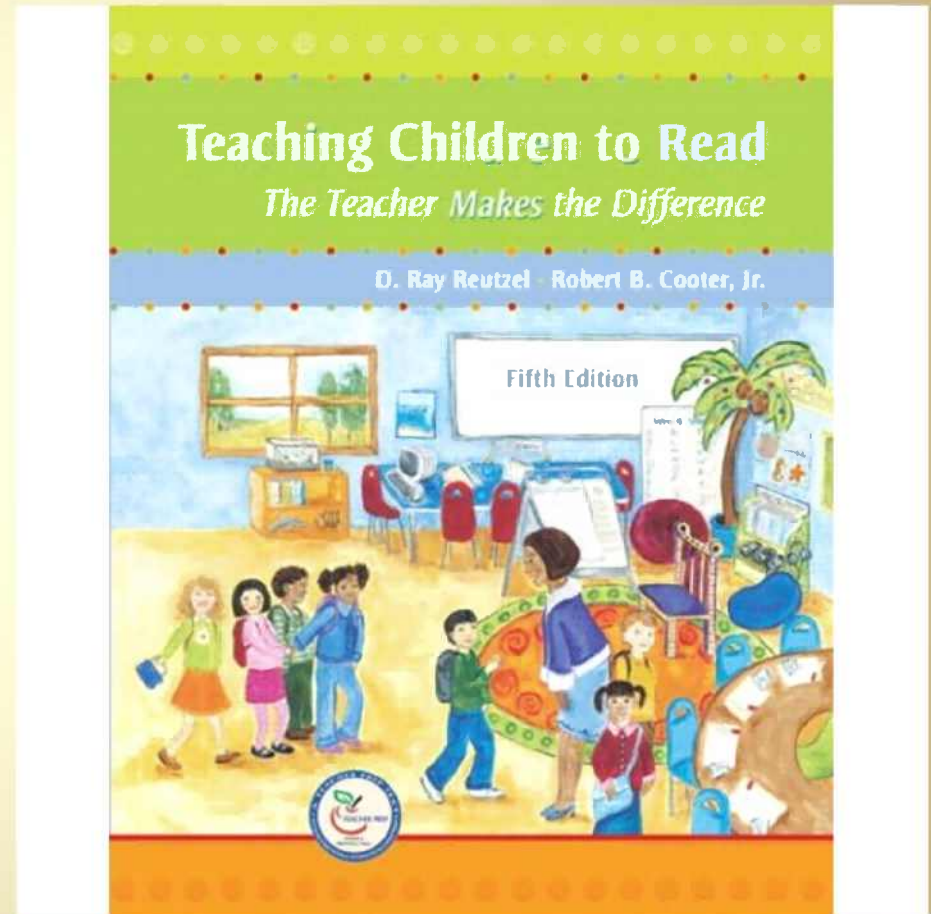

Classroom Management Research Synthesis

- *Haertel, and Walberg (1994) examined 10,000 research reports to determine factors that most influenced student learning in school classrooms. They found there were 28 factors, but that classroom management was one of the two most important factors governing student learning in classrooms along with quantity of instruction.*
 - *A teacher who is, “grossly inadequate in classroom management skills is probably not going to accomplish much” (Wong & Wong, pg. 84).*
