

# Emma Eccles Jones College of Education and Human Services Researcher/Scholar of the Year Award 2009-2010

**Deadline: February 6, 2009**

The annual Emma Eccles Jones College of Education and Human Services Researcher/Scholar of the Year Award recognizes an individual's outstanding research/scholarly contribution(s) **within the prior three years**. The award is presented at the Spring College Awards Ceremony, and the recipient receives \$500 for professional development.

Full-time employees of the College (faculty or staff) are eligible for the award. Any College department, research center, teaching unit, or individual faculty or staff may nominate an individual for the award. A person may receive the award only once in any five-year period. The previous recipients are:

The award is for research/scholarly contributions in the prior three years, and each nomination should be focused on the individual's accomplishments during this period in the areas of:

- (a) scholarly publications
- (b) professional presentations
- (c) grants and contracts
- (d) research teaching/service

Nominations for the Researcher/Scholar of the Year Award must include the following:

1. A letter from the department head summarizing the impact of the awardee's research, scholarship or creative activity on the department and its programs over the past 3 years. In the nomination letter, the nominee's qualifications for the award should be discussed in **750 words or less**.
2. Each nomination letter must be accompanied by two letters of endorsement.
3. A list of honors and awards indicating recognition of the nominee's research, scholarship or creative activity at the national or international level over the past 3 years.
4. A list of research, scholarship or creative publications for the past 3 years. This list should clearly denote graduate and undergraduate coauthors.
5. A list of off-campus participation in research, scholarship or creative works for the past 3 years (e.g. invited seminars, conference presentations, performances). This list should also clearly denote graduate and undergraduate coauthors.
6. A list of all extramural support that has been secured over the past 3 years, with outcomes (if known).
7. A statement from the nominee outlining his/her philosophy and approach toward engaging students in research, scholarship or creative activity, followed by the names of completed MS and PhD students, and undergraduate researchers mentored over the past 3 years.

Submit nominations to the Office of Research Services (Education 453, UMC 2800) by **Friday, February 6, 2008, at 4:00 p.m.** The College Research Council will review the nominations and recommend an awardee to the Dean. (Any Research Council member nominated for the award will not participate in the selection process.) The Council may request further information from the nominating department, center, unit, or individual.
